

The ORIA BFET program provides employment services to refugees and immigrants who have (SNAP) benefits and do not receive TANF, RCA and/or State funded food assistance (FAP). Contractors provide case management employment services that assist individuals move towards self-sufficiency by obtaining employment through activities that may include the following:

- Job search
- Job search training (soft skills)
- Life skills
- Educational services (adult basic education and ESL)
- Vocational education (workforce skills training)
- Assistance with establishing small businesses
- Post-employment job retention and support services
