*Eligibility:

- LEP TANF parents referred by DSHS; or
- RCA recipient; or
- Individuals age 16 and older residing in US for less than 60 months, who have not naturalized as a US citizen and have a current or entry status of a:
 - Refugee.
 - Asylee.
 - For asylees, time in the US is based on the asylum petition's approval date.
 - Victim of human trafficking.
 - For victims of human trafficking, time in the US is based on the date status was certified/approved by the Office of Refugee Resettlement.
 - Amerasian.
 - Cuban-Haitian entrant.
 - Iraqi or Afghan Special Immigrants and their eligible family members.
 - Afghan Humanitarian Parolee
 - Ukrainian Humanitarian Parolee
- Updated guidance from DSHS may expand participant eligibility through SFY24 contract coverage timeframe.
