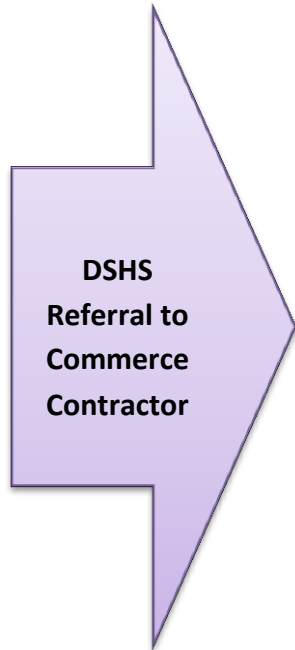


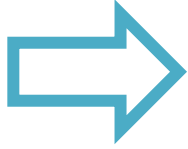
# FY17 Commerce WorkFirst Programs



**Community Jobs (CJ) & Career Jump**

- Focuses on employment barriers and case management
- Up to 6 months of subsidized wages
- Full-time countable activities
- Combines 20 hrs work w/ up to 18 hrs stacked activities
- Stacked activities include GE, HS, JT, LS, VS, XS, JS
- Combines basic skills, vocational, or employment-specific training
- Work-based learning in community worksites support career goal
- Career Jump provides paid work experience w/ employer who hires

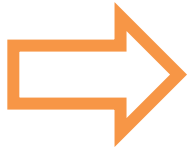


**GOAL**  
Unsubsidized Employment

**Part-Time Community Jobs (CJ)**

- For single parents with child under age of six
- Up to 6 months of subsidized wages
- Countable activities meet participation
- Combines 20 hrs work w/ 3 hrs LS or coded barrier removal or combination of both
- Other stacked activities options available if LS of no benefit
- Work-based learning in community worksites support career goals

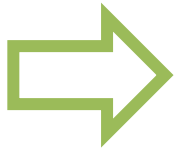


**GOAL**  
Unsubsidized Employment

**Community Works (WC)**

- ❖ Unpaid work experience for 1 – 12 months:
  - Supports education pathway
  - Transition between activities
  - Beginning activity for those w/ limited participation capabilities
  - Working less than 32 hrs/week, need to meet fulltime participation
- ❖ Core activity – minimum 5 hours to FLSA maximum
- ❖ Coaching/support for work-related issues
