## 1.4.7 WorkFirst Orientation - Step-by-Step Guide

The WorkFirst Program Specialist or Social Service Specialist:

- 1. Makes a positive connection with each group/personparticipant.
- 2. Provides an overview of the WorkFirst program, stressing all the opportunities that are available
- 3. Provides accommodations for those who need them or who do not understand English.
- 4. Uses the orientation PowerPoint and WorkFirst Talking Points to make sure the <u>person participant</u> gets a good understanding of the employment pathway, their responsibility to take advantage of what the program offers, how work pays, and <u>that</u> they risk <u>of a lowered or complete</u> lossing <u>of</u> their cash grant <u>for non-participation</u>. if they decide to not participate.
- 5. Provides a WorkFirst folder. DSHS 22-395, to each participant which includes, at a minimum, the following documents:
  - WorkFirst Opportunities Brochure, DSHS 22-1125
  - o Domestic Violence Flyer, DSHS 22-265
