

## 5.2.7 Can LEP parent/caregivers participate in non-LEP Pathway activities?

WorkFirst LEP parent/caregivers can participate in activities outside the LEP pathway. The Work First Program Specialist (WFPS) or Refugee Social Service Specialist (RSW) ~~must shall~~ follow the referral process ~~as outlined in the appropriate WorkFirst chapter as outlined in the appropriate WorkFirst chapter~~ in those cases.

The following core activities are examples:

- ~~Community Jobs - CJ~~ (Note: Some Commerce providers offer LEP CJ)
- On-the-job Training - OT
- Vocational Education - VE
- High Wage High Demand Training - HW
- High School completion or High School equivalency (age 19 or younger) - HS

Non-core activities, ~~that are~~ used to stack with core activities, are also great opportunities when a participant doesn't need ~~encouraged when ESL is not scheduled~~. These activities can include:

- ~~Basic Education~~ High School completion (age 20 or older) - BE
- High School or high school equivalency (age 20 or older) - GE ~~GE, HS~~
