5.2.7 Can LEP parent/caregivers participate in non-LEP Pathway activities?

WorkFirst LEP parent/<u>caregiver</u>s can participate in activities outside the LEP pathway. The Work First Program Specialist (WFPS) or Refugee Social Service Specialist (RSW) <u>must shall</u> follow the referral process <u>as outlined in the appropriate WorkFirst chapter</u> in those cases.

The following <u>core</u> activities are examples:

- •—Community Jobs CJ_(Note: Some Commerce providers offer LEP CJ)
- On-the-job Training OT
- Vocational Education VE
- High Wage High Demand Training HW
- High School completion or High School equivalency (age 19 or younger) HS

Non-core activities, that are used to stack with core activities, are also great opportunities when a participant doesn't needencouraged when ESL. is not scheduled. These activities can include:

- Basic EducationHigh School completion (age 20 or older) BE
- High School or high school equivalency (age 20 or older) GE GE, HS

These activities would be reported by the The non-LEP pathway contractor or agency must report these activities, and the and reviewed by the WFPS/RSW must review them.
