- Based on research done by the Union, there is an overabundance of Spanish and Russian interpreters. A problem is being created by allowing Spanish and Russian speakers to keep taking tests in order to certify; experienced interpreters are leaving the field because there is too much competition for Spanish/Russian appointments.
- Video interpreter should be an option for rural areas with languages of lesser diffusion.
- Testing frequency: save spots for needed languages and move the location for testing to areas that have the demand
- Create map to show what languages are needed and where they are needed.
- Make testing schedule available ONLY for languages of limited diffusion.
- Base testing by language on data collected of from 2015 and first part of 2016
