The "No Decision" category is defined as a Juvenile Offender cases without a case resolution. The data is limited by an "as of" date to ensure consistency between years. If the offender case is not resolved by August of the year following the case filing year, it is included within the No Decision count. "No Decision" cases have been reported as a percentage of cases filed in the case filing year.
