SOLE SOURCE POSTING

The Department of Social & Health Services (DSHS) contemplates awarding a sole source contract to Trillium Behavioral Health dba Silverlake Behavioral Associates to provide, install, configure, maintain, support and providing training on its proprietary Clinical Frequency Reporting System (CFRS) for use by the Fort Steilacoom Competency Restoration Program (FSCRCP), a forensic mental health program in a new residential treatment facility on the Western State Hospital campus in Lakewood.

DSHS found this Contractor's proprietary off the shelf CFRS solution to be specifically designed to track and schedule active treatment in the context of competency restoration treatment in forensic behavioral health care settings like the FSCRCP.

The contract will be issued on or about March 15, 2019 through March 14, 2024. The dollar value is estimated at \$35,000 for use of the application as well as the installation, configuration, training and maintenance and support.

Offerors contemplating the above requirements are required to submit capability statements detailing their ability to meet the state's requirements within five (5) working days of this announcement.

The following information should be included in the capability statements:

- Evidence of capability, authority and experience allowing the offeror to license, install, configure, support, maintain and provide training on the proprietary Clinical Frequency Reporting System that is the subject of this planned sole source contract
- Capability, authority and experience allowing the offeror to license, install, configure, support, maintain and provide training on an equivalent system that has a track record of use in more than one state forensic competency restoration programs and that includes the functionality of tracking the delivery active treatment measures in the context of competency restoration and of scheduling appropriate active treatment measures in this context.
- Ability to perform the initial installation, configuration and training in March 2019

In the absence of other qualified sources, it is the state's intent to make a sole source award of the contract.
