Child Adult

- Psychological evaluations, neuropsych testing. Service must be provided by licensed psychologist, limited to two services per lifetime. Does not include EPSDT evaluations.
- OP individual, family and group therapy. Can be provided by DOH licensed psychiatrist, psychologist, ARNP, social worker, marriage and family therapist or mental health counselor. Clinician must have at least two years clinical experience with children and youth. Service limited to one hour per day per client, maximum of 20 hours per year.
- Inpatient Services are covered through RSN Managed Care System
- Med Management provided by physician or psych ARNP. Not subject to duration limitations.

- Psychological evaluations, neuropsych testing. Service must be provided by licensed psychologist, limited to two services per lifetime
- OP individual, family and group therapy. Services can only be provided by psychiatrist. If on Managed Care, services may be provided by licensed MHPs. Service limited to one hour per day per client, maximum of 12 hours per year.
- Inpatient Services are covered through RSN Managed Care System
- Med Management provided by physician or psych ARNP. Not subject to duration limitations.

- Fee for service model: Encounter Rate
- Service scope, duration, frequency and intensity determined by medical necessity and ordered through treatment plan; no limit on benefit for medically necessary services
- AI/AN consumers served by Tribal programs not required to meet *Access to Care Standards* or have covered diagnosis.
- Encounter Rate services may only be provided by MHP
- Current credential from other states is valid
- Medical Necessity can only be determined by an MHP.
- Services must fit within mental health Rehab Section of Medicaid State Plan

- Managed Care model.
- Service scope, duration, frequency and intensity determined by medical necessity and ordered through treatment plan; no limit on benefit for medically necessary services
- Services provided through RSN system require consumers to meet *Access to Care Standards* and to have a covered diagnosis
- Services may only be provided by DOH credentialed MHP or MHCP, all care provided under supervision of an MHP.
- Medical Necessity can only be determined by an MHP.
- Services must fit within mental health Rehab Section of Medicaid State Plan
