Oversees the Division of Child Support's intergovernmental tribal child support efforts. Supervises DCS Tribal Relations Team, works closely with DCS Leadership on statewide tribal strategic planning initiatives and best practices, and provides guidance, support, and recommendations to DCS Tribal Liaisons, Tribal Claims Officers, and District Managers. Has primary statewide responsibility for fostering healthy relationships and strong partnerships with the twenty-nine (29) federally-recognized Indian Tribes in Washington State. Lead responsibility for the formulation of statewide DCS tribal child support policies (in partnership with the DCS Policy Unit) that are consistent with state and federal policies and laws. Oversees and directs the drafting and negotiations of Intergovernmental contracts and agreements with Indian Nations, including Cooperative Child Support Agreements, Tribal TANF Child Support Agreements, SEMS Web Data Share Agreements, and Federal Offset Certification Agreements. Directs the content and maintenance of public information on the DCS Tribal Relations Internet Website (www.dshs.wa.gov/dcs/tribal), oversees the development of tribal child support educational materials, and provides technical assistance and training for DCS staff and Tribal representatives.
