



# PREPROPOSAL STATEMENT OF INQUIRY

**CR-101 (June 2004)**  
(Implements RCW 34.05.310)  
Do NOT use for expedited rule making

**Agency:** Department of Social and Health Services, Aging and Long-Term Care Support Administration

**Subject of possible rule making:**  
The department is proposing to add new sections, repeal existing sections, and amend sections in chapter 388-107 WAC "Licensing Requirements for Enhanced Services Facilities" related to tuberculosis screening including WAC 388-107-0440, WAC 388-107-0450, WAC 388-107-0460, WAC 388-107-0465, WAC 388-107-0470, WAC 388-107-0480, WAC 388-107-0490, WAC 388-107-0500, WAC 388-107-0510, WAC 388-107-0520, WAC 388-107-0530, WAC 388-107-0540, WAC 388-107-0542, and other related rules as may be required.

**Statutes authorizing the agency to adopt rules on this subject:**  
Chapter 70.97 RCW, Chapter 74.39A RCW

**Reasons why rules on this subject may be needed and what they might accomplish:**  
These rules have not been updated in seven years or more and are unclear, ambiguous, and inaccurate. The rules need to be updated to include the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention recommendations, as well as the Department of Health regulations. These rule changes will create consistent regulations across the Residential Care Services programs.

**Identify other federal and state agencies that regulate this subject and the process coordinating the rule with these agencies:**  
The Washington Department of Health collaborates and coordinates closely with the Department of Social and Health Services (DSHS), Residential Care Services to develop regulations of the requirements associated with tuberculosis in chapter 388-107 WAC "Licensing Requirements for Enhanced Services Facilities", and other related rules as may be necessary.
