- 3. Complete all requirements assigned by Skills Inc. Human Resources (includes basic background check, drug test, and verifying personal identification documents).
- 4. Receive official communication from Skills HR via phone/email to confirm start date.
- 5. Show up on time for Day 1 Intern Orientation at our headquarters in Auburn.
