1. The Contractor shall provide Work-Based Learning Experiences to a Student on an individual basis, when the Contractor and Regional Transition Consultant identify that a Student cannot acquire the intended outcomes and skill acquisition in a group setting.
2. The Contractor shall be reimbursed compensation for the amount of wages paid to a student, plus a flat fee of 15.0% for payroll taxes and related personnel costs paid by the Contractor for each Student who participates in a Work-Based Learning Paid Internship.
 - a. A Contractor may be reimbursed compensation for the amount of wages paid to a student, plus a flat fee of 15.0% for payroll taxes and related personnel costs paid by the Contractor for up to a maximum of *100 hours*.
3. Students participating in a Work-Based Learning Paid Internship are paid at or above the state prevailing minimum wage to perform a non-permanent job at an employer's worksite.
4. Contractors utilizing an Interlocal Agreement may place Students at a contractor site.
 - a. Contractors who utilize an interlocal agreement, and place Students into Work Based Learning Paid Internships at a Contractor Site, shall only be reimbursed as stated in *2a* above;
 - b. Contractors who utilize an interlocal agreement shall not receive the hourly rate, when a Student is placed into a Work-Based Learning Paid Internship at a Contractor Site.
5. The Contractor shall be paid for each quarter hour of service provided, once the contractor completes a full hour, or sixty minutes, of a Pre-ETS service within a Workshop for each Student receiving Pre-ETS.
 - a. The rate paid for quarter hour increments shall be one quarter of \$70.
