

The HCBS Waiver and Community First Choice (CFC) programs are authorized in 1915(c) and 1918 Security Act and allow states to offer services in the community to prevent individuals eligible for Me institutionalized. HCBS Waiver recipients must be assessed to meet an Intermediate Care Facility f Intellectual Disabilities (ICF/IID) Level of Care. CFC recipients must be assessed to meet an ICF/IID Nursing Facility Level of Care (NFLOC).
