I understand that by my refusal of Community Protection Services, I will also be removed from the Home and Community Based Services Waiver because my health and safety needs can no longer be met. I understand that if I request Community Protection Services in the future that my placement is not guaranteed and that any request will be evaluated based on program availability, risk evaluation, DDA eligibility, and other factors.		
I understand that I will continue to be identified as an individual with community protection issues with the Developmental Disabilities Administration.		
I further understand that refusal to sign this statement will be considered refusal of Community Protection Program services.
