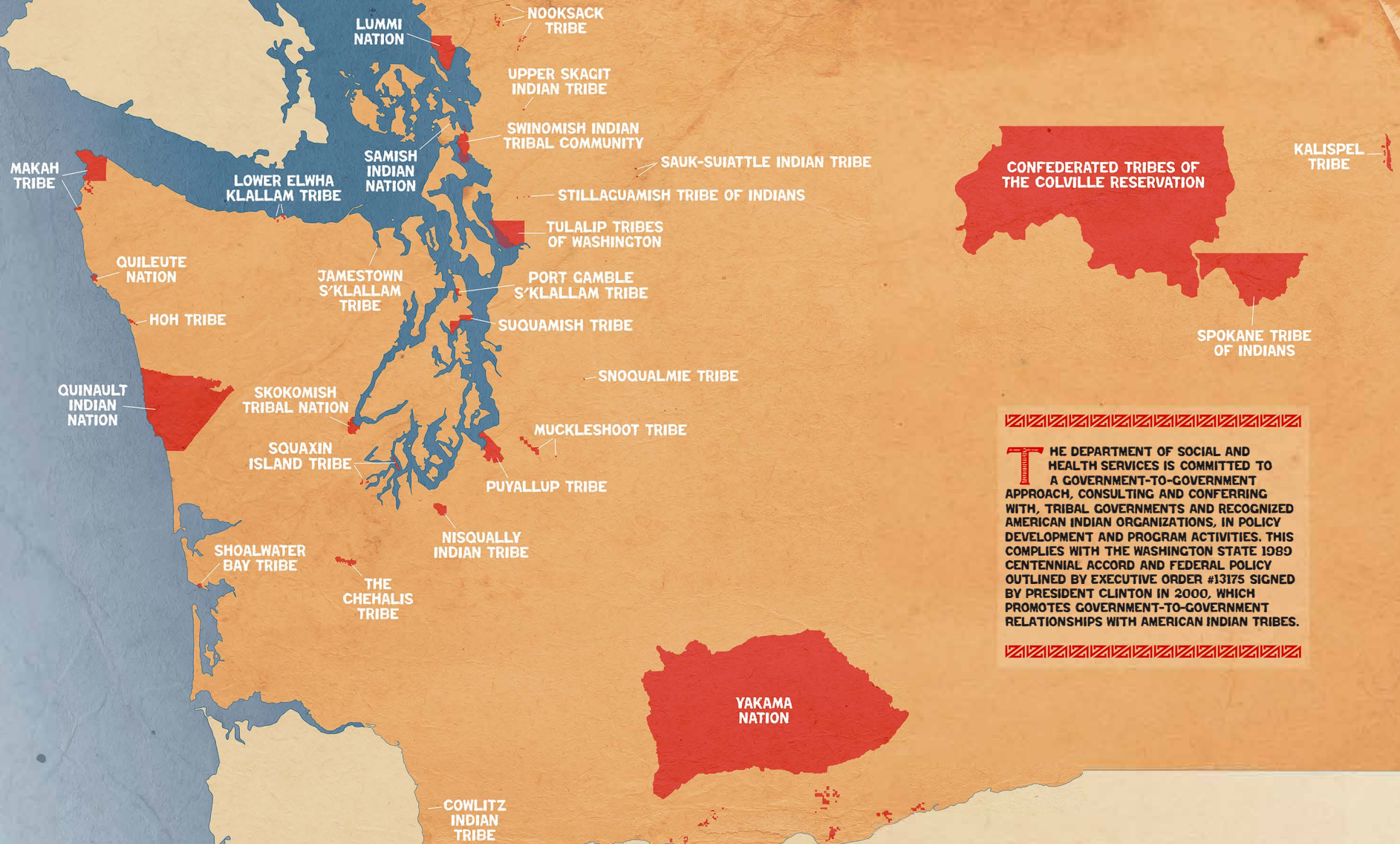


FEDERALLY RECOGNIZED TRIBES IN WASHINGTON STATE
