

# Public Safety Review Panel

## Minutes for the Meeting of December 19, 2022 Conducted via Zoom

**Call to Order:** The meeting convened via conference call at approximately 12:35 p.m. A quorum of members was present.

**Members Present:** David Hackett, Kari Reardon, Donta Harper, Katherine Michaelsen, David Singley, and non-voting staff Lisa Wolph.

**Guests Present:** Dr. Elizabeth Zinda, NGRI Specialist Administrator; Jenise Gogan, Director of Community Transition, Aaron Goddu, incoming Interim Director of Community Transition

### a. Business Meeting: (12:35 – 1:10)

- a) Jenise Gogan announced she has accepted a role as a Special Assistant focused on Community Bed Capacity, a 12-month role beginning December 16<sup>th</sup>. She will be overseeing BHA's civil and forensic RTFs, to include the competency restoration facilities and the opening of the new civil and NGRI facilities. She will continue working closely with HCA and BHA; lead in securing and coordinating additionally contracted community bed capacity within local behavioral health facilities. Arron Goddu, the current BHA Civil Capacity Manager, will temporarily backfill as the Director of Community Transitions. Additionally, ESH's SW Director, Simone Gardner, will be taking a Special Assistant position focused on implementing the Civil Discharge Negotiations and the discharge system build. Aaron Goddu introduced himself and briefed the Panel on his background.
- b) Jenise discussed the 1114 status patients' level and privilege system. This system varies between hospitals and is not a formalized standard level system. Work is currently being done on this system. WSH has developed a new system modeled after NGRI Community Access Program. Waiting on final policy and procedure approval. There is currently nothing formal. At ESH they have one civil level system. Will be discussing modeling similar Community Access Program that is based on privileges and risk.
- c) The Panel requested:
  - i. Clarification regarding the December 14<sup>th</sup> Assistant Secretary Bovenkamp memo announcing a hospital admission triaging policy. Does this policy apply to NGRI and/or 1114 patients?
  - ii. The Panel also requested statistic on how the percentage of competency findings varies the past three years.
  - iii. For the January PSRP meeting, what is DSHS going to be pursuing in the legislature to provide quicker release for these issues?
- d) Staff Update: The Governor's Boards & Commissions has extended David Hackett and Kari Reardon terms until 12/10/23. Katherine has been reappointed for another three-year term.
- e) The Panel discussed Panel member roles. As of January 23, 2023, Kari Reardon will serve as the PSRP Chair and Katherine Michaelsen will serve as the Vice-Chair.
- f) Minutes from the 11/21/22 meeting were approved.
