

DSHS Community Instructor — Qualification Requirements

All instructors must:

1. Be 21 years of age.
2. Have **not** had a professional health care or social services license or certification revoked in Washington state.
3. **In addition to the general qualifications listed below**, an instructor must meet the following qualifications for DSHS approval:

Core Basic Training^{2, 8} Population Specific Training²	Active Washington state RN license in good standing with work experience within the last five years with clients of long-term care community setting OR AA Degree, or higher, in health or human services and six months of professional or caregiving experience within the last 5 years in long-term care community setting OR High school diploma/GED, and one year of professional or caregiving experience within the last five years in long-term care community setting	100 hours teaching adults topics in basic training OR 40 hours of teaching basic training while being mentored by an instructor who is approved to teach basic training	Prerequisites: Adult Education ⁶ course completion Required Documentation: Adult Education certificate Applications: Community Instructor Training Program Application and Updates and Community Instructor Application

<p>Expanded Specialty Training^{7,8} includes the following courses:</p> <p>Traumatic Brain Injury Specialty</p> <p>Diabetes Specialty</p>	<p>The instructor must be experienced in caregiving practices related to the expanded specialty topic and capable of demonstrating competency in the entire course content</p> <p>AND</p> <p>Bachelor's degree, registered nurse, paramedic, emergency medical technician (EMT), mental health specialist, or a specialist with nationally recognized credentials in the expanded specialty topic with at least 80 hours of education in seminars, conferences, continuing education, or accredited college classes, in subjects directly related to expanded specialty topics</p> <p>AND</p> <p>Two years full-time equivalent direct work or volunteer experience with people in the specialty topic population</p> <p>NOTE: Five years of full-time equivalent direct work experience with people in the specialty topic population may substitute for either:</p> <p>The credential or degree described above</p> <p>OR</p> <p>The 80 hours in seminars, conferences, continuing education</p>	<p>200 hours experience teaching</p> <p>AND</p> <p>Successful completion of the DSHS instructor qualification/demonstration process</p> <p>AND</p> <p>The instructor has been approved and contracted by the department as a community instructor</p> <p>AND</p> <p>Instructors who will administer tests must have experience or training in assessment and competency testing</p>	<p>Prerequisites: Expanded Specialty Training and Adult Education⁶ course completion</p> <p>Required Documentation: Expanded Specialty Training certificate(s) and Adult Education certificate</p> <p>Applications: Community Instructor Training Program Application and Updates and Community Instructor Application</p>
