DID YOU KNOW?

If Developmental Disabilities Administration determined you are not eligible, you may receive other supports through your Managed Care Organization or a community partner.

APPLIED BEHAVIOR ANALYSIS SERVICES

ABA is available for children as well as adults over the age of 20.



Ensure the individual is enrolled or eligible for Apple Health.



A referral for an evaluation is required. Although a referral can be written by anyone (the individual, family member, primary care provider, licensed health care practitioner), a majority of Centers of Excellence require a referral from the individual's PCP.



COE completes the evaluation to determine eligibility for ABA treatment.

NOTE: Please contact your MCO directly to discuss program benefits. You can request an ABA case manager to assist in scheduling an evaluation with a COE and to help identify ABA providers enrolled in your plan. For questions about ABA services, please email <u>ABA@hca.wa.gov</u>.

CARE COORDINATION

Are you experiencing difficulty connecting to a provider? Are you looking for a primary care provider, dentist, or other medical or mental health provider? Did you know when you work with your MCO you can request a care coordinator? Contact your MCO and request a care coordinator who can assist with connecting you to needed providers or medical care.

DIVISION OF VOCATIONAL REHABILITATION AND BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES

DSHS offers additional services including <u>DVR</u> and <u>BHS</u> you may qualify and benefit from if you are not eligible for DDA services.

HOME AND COMMUNITY SERVICES

If you are not eligible for DDA services, you may be eligible for Home and Community Services. HCS provides long-term care services for persons with disabilities and the elderly who may need state fund assistance.
