Our Team Can Help

Caregivers

Navigate the healthcare system, find specialists and assist with Apple Health benefit denials and prior authorizations.

Social Workers and Tribal Social Workers

Answer medical questions, review medical records, create child-specific comprehensive health overviews and assist with Apple Health denials and prior authorizations.

Program Eligibility

FWB can help if the child receives Apple Health (Medicaid fee-for-service) and is:

- Birth to 18 years old in foster care or up to 21 years old in extended foster care.
- American Indian/Alaskan Native (tribal affiliated, tribal custody payment only with DCYF), a non-citizen or enrolled in Medically Intensive Children's Program.
