Community Project: Connecting Kids to Themselves, Their Families, and Their Communities

Abstract

Youth and families in Walla Walla County are considered more likely to suffer the consequences of alcohol and drug abuse, based on the measurement of standardized risk factors. Poverty and school dropout rates are significantly above the state average. Risk factors identified were friends who engage in problem behavior, extreme economic and social deprivation, family history of highrisk behavior, favorable attitudes toward drug use, family management problems, availability of drugs, and parental attitudes and involvement. Efforts will focus on a selective population at Pioneer Middle School and College Place Intermediate School and a universal population throughout the county. Additional selective populations will be served in Years Two and Three as programs are replicated.


Recruitment for Parent Navigator program for parents is through schools, churches, social service organizations, and the media in both English and Spanish. The goal is to provide information on healthful alternatives to using drugs, alcohol, tobacco, and other self-defeating behaviors. Life Skills Training, Parent Navigator, and Across Ages were selected based on their ability to mitigate the county risk factors, appropriateness for implementation at target middle schools, and potential for replication throughout the county.
