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INTRODUCTION

Nationally, an increasing number of employers faced with rising employee health care premium costs either have chosen to drop health care benefits for their employees or to pass on to their employees a greater share of coverage costs. As a consequence, more employees and their dependents either go without health insurance, apply for state purchased health care programs supported with public funds, or seek uncompensated care at hospitals and community clinics.

In response to these trends, the 2006 State Legislature enacted Engrossed Substitute House Bill (ESHB) 3079. This legislation directed the Department of Social and Health Services (DSHS) and the Health Care Authority (HCA) in coordination with the Employment Security Department (ESD) to report annually on the employment status of Medical Assistance clients and Basic Health Program (BHP) enrollees. This report provides both aggregate and employer-specific data related to DSHS Medical Assistance clients and non-client parents with dependents with DSHS medical coverage, as specified in the legislation (enacted as Chapter 264, Laws of 2006 and codified in RCW 70.47.170).

Governor Gregoire signed ESHB 3079, but vetoed the emergency clause included in the bill. The Governor's veto message urged caution when interpreting information provided in this report:

The employer information to be provided by the Health Care Authority (HCA) and the Department of Social and Health Services (DSHS) is not a requirement for enrollment or eligibility. Consequently, data contained in the reports will have been provided on a voluntary basis, and will be unverified. The two reports – an employer specific report and an aggregated report – will originate from separate sources. Therefore, they will not be comparable. The reports will also be based on a point-in-time data collection and will therefore not reflect changes in employment status. These data limitations must be considered when interpreting the reports.

The Governor also noted the programs provide health care services to eligible working persons and expressed concern that the information "not be misconstrued to portray beneficiaries of our Basic Health and Medicaid programs in a negative light."

ESHB 3079 directs DSHS to provide two separate sets of information related to DSHS Medical Assistance clients and non-client parents with dependents with DSHS medical coverage:

- Aggregate data for calendar year (CY) 2005 by industry, firm size, and public/private ownership type. These data are based on ESD quarterly wage data.
- By-firm data for January and June 2006 for employers associated with 50 or more persons with DSHS medical coverage. These data are based on DSHS Automated Client Eligibility System (ACES) employer name data.

DATA SOURCES AND LIMITATIONS

Aggregate data by industry, firm size, and public/private ownership type are based on ESD quarterly earnings data and monthly DSHS medical eligibility data for CY 2005. ESD earnings data do not include self-employment or unreported earnings.

By-firm data are based on ACES employer name data linked to DSHS medical eligibility data for January and June 2006. ACES employer name information does not permit the identification of separately owned franchises operating under the same business name. The employer name information used in this report is self-reported; it is not a required element of the application for public assistance and is not independently verified by DSHS.

Employer rankings are based on the combined number of associated DSHS medical clients in January and June 2006. If a firm was below the 50-client threshold specified by ESHB 3079 in one of the two months, we suppressed all data for that month and did not use the client count for that month in determining the employer's rank.

The tables report the number of DSHS clients or persons with dependents with DSHS medical coverage who were employed, and the associated "member months" by type of coverage. Coverage type was determined based on Medicaid Management Information System (MMIS) program, match, and medical codes.

The Family Medical coverage group includes persons receiving TANF and related medical coverage. The Children's Medical and SCHIP programs provide medical coverage to children in families that do not meet TANF eligibility criteria but have household income below 200 percent (Children's Medical) or 250 percent (SCHIP) of the Federal Poverty Guidelines. This coverage group also includes a small number of children enrolled in Foster Care or Adoptions Support coverage. The Pregnant Women program provides Medicaid coverage to low-income pregnant women. The

Persons with Disabilities coverage group includes persons enrolled in Medicaid Disabled, Medicaid Blind, General Assistance, and Alcohol and Drug Abuse Treatment and Support Act (ADATSA) coverage. The "Other" coverage group includes a small number of persons receiving DSHS medical coverage through programs for refugees and the elderly. Clients who received only Take Charge family planning coverage were excluded.

Employed non-client persons with dependents with DSHS medical coverage were counted if they were part of a household with at least one person who received DSHS medical coverage. To be counted, the employed person had to be identified as the head of household, spouse, or unmarried co-parent of a child in common with the head of household.

Counts of employed clients or persons with dependents with DSHS medical coverage were associated with a single "primary employer" in each month. The vast majority of employed clients or persons with dependents with DSHS medical coverage had a single employer in the month. In cases where the person had more than one employer in the month, the primary employer was defined to be the employer from whom the person received the greatest earnings.

To create an unduplicated count of member months and HRSA expenditures associated with employed persons, in the cases where a dependent was associated with more than one employed person, we associated the dependent with the person who had the highest earnings. For the CY 2005 aggregate data tables, per member per month HRSA Medical Assistance expenditure estimates were based on the average of November 2006 forecast per capita estimates for SFY 2005 and SFY 2006. Per member per month HRSA Mental Health expenditure estimates were based on statewide average RSN capitation rates for SFY 2005 and SFY 2006.

For the by-firm tables, per member per month HRSA Medical Assistance expenditure estimates were based on November 2006 forecast estimates for SFY 2006. Per member per month HRSA Mental Health expenditure estimates were based on statewide average RSN capitation rates for SFY 2006.

KEY FINDINGS

1. In the average quarter in CY 2005, there were 107,900 persons with DSHS medical coverage and ESD-reported earnings in the quarter (see Table 1A "All Firms"). This represents 12 percent of all persons with DSHS medical coverage in the average quarter in CY 2005.
2. In the average quarter in CY 2005, there were 132,162 employed non-client persons with dependents with DSHS coverage (see Table 1B "All Firms").
3. Combining employed clients and non-client persons, there were 240,062 employed clients or non-client persons with dependents with DSHS medical coverage in the average calendar quarter in CY 2005 (see Table 1 "All Firms").
4. Employed non-client persons with dependents with DSHS medical coverage worked more hours than employed DSHS medical clients. Median hours per week were 35 for employed non-client persons, compared to 17 hours per week for employed clients.
5. In the average quarter in CY 2005, there were 425,765 DSHS covered lives associated with employed DSHS clients and persons with dependents with DSHS medical coverage. This represents 46 percent of all persons with DSHS medical coverage in the average quarter in CY 2005.
6. There were about 4.8 million months of DSHS medical coverage associated with employed DSHS clients and non-client persons with dependents with DSHS medical coverage. Forty-eight percent of the medical coverage months were associated with employed DSHS clients (2,279,507 months), and 52 percent were associated with employed non-client persons with dependents with DSHS coverage (2,518,600 months).
7. Estimated DSHS medical and mental health expenditures for the months of coverage associated with employed clients and non-client persons with dependents with DSHS coverage were \$1.12 billion in CY 2005 (all funds). Of this total, \$651 million were associated with employed DSHS medical clients, and \$469 million were associated with employed non-client persons with dependents with DSHS medical coverage.
8. Associated annual DSHS coverage costs were greatest for persons employed in the following industries: Health and Social Assistance (\$163 million); Retail Trade (\$154 million); and Accommodation and Food Services (\$143 million).
9. Almost all (92 percent) of the annual DSHS coverage costs were associated with private employers (\$1.036 billion), as opposed to public employers (\$84 million).
