Subject of possible rule making: The department is planning to amend WAC 388-474-0020, What can an aged, blind or disabled (ABD) cash assistance client expect when supplemental security income (SSI) benefits begin? and other related rules as appropriate.

Statutes authorizing the agency to adopt rules on this subject: RCW 74.04.005, RCW 74.04.050, RCW 74.04.057, RCW 74.04.510, RCW 74.04.630, RCW 74.04.655, RCW 74.04.770, RCW 74.04.0052, RCW 74.08.043, RCW 74.08.090, RCW 74.08.335, RCW 74.08A.100.

Reasons why rules on this subject may be needed and what they might accomplish: Planned amendments are necessary to support a corrective action plan and address errors when an ABD client signs an interim assistance reimbursement authorization (IARA). Amendments are also intended to support ABD program outcomes and better align with Social Security Administration policies and procedures.
