Purpose: The department is repealing Chapter 388-877B WAC – Substance Use Disorder, Detoxification Services. The legislature passed 2ESHB 1388, transferring portions of the responsibility for Behavioral Health to the Department of Health and portions to the Health Care Authority effective July 1, 2018. The rules in this chapter will be rewritten under the Department of Health and the Health Care Authority, therefore no longer needed by the Department of Social and Health Services. Effective July 1, 2018 DSHS no longer has the authority to oversee this program.


